MICHIGAN EQUINE LIABILITY LAW

By submitting an entry, the competitor agrees that they, the owner, handler, trainer, parent and anyone associated with exhibiting a horse at Forever Free Farms Dressage Schooling Shows waives all claims against the show, show management, Forever Free Farms and its employees, the facility, its owners and agents for any injuries to themselves, attendants or horses. When coming onto the show grounds of Forever Free Farms, every competitor, owner, handler, trainer, parent, guardian and spectator automatically assumes the risks associated with equine activities covered under the Michigan Equine Liability Law, 1994 Public Act No. 351.

FOREVER FREE FARMS DRESSAGE SCHOOLING SHOW RULES

(Forever Free Farms Dressage Schooling Shows may be referred to as FFFDSS in this Omnibus)
USDF/USEF Rules Apply. Open to all breeds.

TESTS:

FFFDSS uses the current USDF tests. Horse and rider combinations may be entered in two consecutive levels only. FFFDSS test scores may be submitted for MDA yearend awards by MDA members.

HELMETS:

ASTM approved helmets must be worn by all minors when mounted. Adults who file a waiver at the show office.

ATTIRE & TACK:

USDF Rules apply.

DIVISIONS:

Jr/Yg Rider: (Jr/Yg): up to 21 years old as of 1/01/2010. Junior/Young Riders may ride in Open classes. Novice Rider: (NR): a rider in his or her first 2 seasons of dressage shows. Novice Horse: (NH): a horse or pony in its first 2 show seasons of dressage classes.

CLASSES:

There will be no changes of classes after the show's closing date unless the change is deemed necessary by show management or staff. If a rider has entered a class he or she is not eligible for, the entry fee must be forfeited. Classes may be added for an already entered participant on the day of the show at the discretion of show management. If time permits. A late fee of \$10.00 per class will be added to the \$20 per class fee for all added classes after closing date.

RIDE TIMES:

Shows start at 9 AM. Changes in ride times may be made by show management after publication of ride times. Check posted ride times at www.foreverfreeinc.com or at the show office.

STABLING:

Is optional and is limited. Stalls will be reserved based on the dates that show entries are received (not postmarked). If no stall is available, stall fees will be refunded, and the entrant will be notified prior to the show.

SHOWING FROM TRAILER/NON-SHOWING HORSES:

Horses showing from trailers will be charged a \$15 Haul-In Fee per entry.

Non-competing horses on the showgrounds will be charged a \$25 fee.

Horses tied to trailers must be attended to at all times. No liability will be assumed by Forever Free Farms for a tied horse or a loose horse or any damages they may cause.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS:

Up to 6 ribbons per class and High Percentage awards will be presented at each show.

Champion and Reserve Champion awards will be presented to the highest and next highest point earners in their level and division. To be eligible for Champion and Reserve Champion year end awards, riders must show the same horse in 3 FFFDSS that year. FOOTING/ARENAS:

Manicured indoor, outdoor sand arenas and lunging area.

DOGS :

Please keep your dog on a leash at all times and clean up after it.

DISPUTES:

Disputes involving show results in a class will be resolved by the judge. Any other dispute will be settled by show management.

ENTRIES:

Must be accompanied payment and current Coggins. NO posted dated checks or day of show.

SIGNATURES:

No entry will be accepted without all correct and complete signatures.

NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST:

No entry will be accepted without a photocopy of a current negative Coggins test for each horse brought onto the show grounds.

ENTRY FORM :

One entry form must be submitted per each horse and rider combination.

CLOSING DATE/ENTRY ACCEPTANCE/LATE ENTRIES:

The closing date is the date by which an entry must be received – not the postmarked date. Entries received after the closing date are late and will be charged an additional \$10 per class, if accepted. Entries will be accepted until the show is full or closing date, whichever comes first.

REFUNDS: There will be NO refunds after closing date.

RETURNED CHECKS: A processing fee of \$50 will be charged by Forever Free Farms for any checks returned by the bank for any reason. Failure to settle debt with Forever Free Farms will result in the loss of all credits towards Year End Awards and will result in the loss of the privilege of showing at future forever Free Farms Dressage Schooling Shows until debt is resolved.

STABLING: \$35/overnight or \$25/day of show

BEDDING: \$8/bale. (No bedding can be ordered day of show.)

HAUL-IN FEE: not stabled) \$15

NCH - NON-COMPETING HORSE: \$25.00

OFFICE FEE: \$10
